"Every commander hopes to surprise the enemy, but in lke's case surprise was crucial, because he was on the offensive with forces that were numerically woefully inferior. Ike's one great material advantage was Allied air superiority. On the ground the Germans had 59 divisions in France, while the initial Allied assault would be only seven divisions strong. By no means were those German divisions contemptible garrison troops—they were armed with the latest weapons, including tanks, and their morale was high. Many were veterans of the Eastern Front. The Allies therefore needed to do better than simply surprise the enemy—they had to induce Hitler to move the best of his units, especially the panzer divisions, away from the invasion site, and keep them away."—Stephen Ambrose
















Succumbs at 73; **Ill Since Sunday**

MOSCOW, March 6 (UP)-Joseph Stalin, 73, died last night in the Kremlin, it was announced today.

The Soviet government and the Communist Party announced with "profound sorrow" that the brain hemorrhage which Stalin suffered Sunday night had brought the death of "the wise leader and teacher of the Communist Party and the Societ people."

The announcement, distributed by the Tass news agency, said death came at 9:50 pm (7:50 pm Germany time).

The people of Russia first learned of Stalin's death at 6:05 am today (4:05 am Germany time)-eight hours and 15 minutes after it occurred.





Hitherto acceptable norms of human conduct do not apply. It the United States is to survive, longstanding American concepts of 'fair play' must be reconsidered. We must develop effective espionage and counterespionage services and must learn to subvert, sabotage, and destroy our enemies by more clever, more sophisticated and more effective methods than those used against us. It may become necessary that the American people be made acquainted with, understand and support this fundamentally repugnant philosophy."—The Doolittle Report












Sputnik 1: The space race begins The first artificial satellite was successfully launched



Failure of NASA's first Satellite -Vanguard TV3


- On Dec. 6, 1957, two months after the Soviets launched the Sputnik (first artificial satellite) into orbit, the U.S. tried to launch its own which failed.






U-2 Wreckage





